


Endemic Diseases

Endemic- disease with a constant predictable (expected) rate of new cases over a specified time.

Geographic location is also a key factor. For example, the expected number of infections caused by mosquito bites are higher in the southern states than in the northern states due to breeding and life span of mosquitos in the warmer climates.

Endemic diseases are not without suffering





Epidemic Diseases

Epidemics or Outbreaks occur when you have more than the predicted rate of infection of an endemic or novel disease in a population over a specified time.

Percentage of tested specimens in the U.S. positive for influenza Type A






Global Covid-19 cases

— White •••• Black — Hispanic and Latino




Sotrovimab


The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Nowcast data from April 5, 2022, estimates that the proportion of COVID-19 cases caused by the Omicron BA.2 variant is above 50% in all Health and Human Services (HHS) U.S. regions. Data included in the health care provider fact sheet show the authorized dose of sotrovimab is unlikely to be effective against the BA.2 sub-variant. Due to these data, sotrovimab is not authorized in any U.S. state or territory at this time.







64 COVID-19 Hospitalizations as of April 8, 2022




